Yes. Everyone will need to check-in at the Registration Table. Please bring a photo ID to get your wristband.

#### Will there be food available?

Yes. Local restaurants will have food available for purchase.

### Will there be alcohol at the event?

Yes. The Braidwood Lions Club will be selling beer and wine coolers to those 21 years of age or older in the gated beer tent area. Only those 21 years of age or older will be allowed in the gated beer tent area.
